Some are standing projects, others are ones that are envisioned and for which funding is being sought. There is something here for all interests and skill levels. See something that interests you? - <u>Annual Cleanups</u>: Riverwide: Spring trash removal from designated sites.
- <u>Special Cleanups</u>: Bowie, Laurel and Odenton: Clean and beautify selected sites by removing trash.
- <u>Tree plantings</u>: Central and Southern Patuxent. reforestation of sensitive and sediment prone areas.
- Water Quality Monitoring: Riverwide. Develop a network of local water testers who can pool their data for more global snapshot of the total watershed.
- <u>Fish Blockage Removal</u>: Little Patuxent areas near Columbia. Moderate exertion.
- <u>Tire Dump Removal</u>: Southern, MD in St. Mary's. Deep ravines, many tires. Physically challenging work.
